Trash and Recycling Collection Services During Heavy Rains

Heavy rains are anticipated during this winter season. These heavy rains may flood the street gutters and potentially wash away collection carts and loose items in its way. In preparation for these heavy rains, listed below are helpful guidelines that residents can follow:

- Ensure street gutters and alleys are clear of trash and loose or bulky items that could potentially interfere with storm drainage.
- On your day of service, during heavy rain place collection carts 2 feet away from the curb to keep the street gutters clear.
- Attempt to only set out collection carts that are full in order to weigh them down and avoid having them tip over or float away with the running water.
- Return carts promptly onto your property after they have been emptied in order to prevent them from floating away.
- Avoid setting out loose, bulky or bagged items for collection on days when heavy rain is expected.

Don't forget to remove your trash and recycling carts before 6 a.m. the day following your regular scheduled collection day.

Rain Barrels Save Money and the Environment

Interested in saving money on your water bill? Passionate about doing your part to help the environment? Consider installing a rain barrel! Rain barrels help to save money on your water bill by catching the water that lands on your roof and using it to water your yard. Using rainwater to water your yard reduces outdoor use of drinking water which saves you money. It also saves energy- a fifth of all power generated in California goes into moving, treating, and using water. By collecting the water from your own roof, you are saving water and energy! On top of savings on your water bill, there are also rebates available to help cover some of the costs of installing a rain barrel. 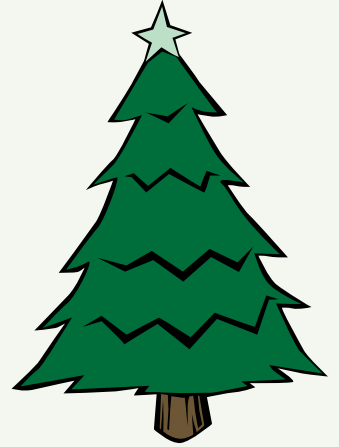

3. If your tree is over 6 ft. tall please cut in half.
4. Place the Holiday tree at curbside on your regular collection day.



Holiday Collection Schedule

Collection service will not run on these holidays:

- ◆ New Year's Day
- ◆ Memorial Day
