ORGANICS



Place all food in a clear or transparent plastic bag, tied securely, then place in the organics cart

- Grass Clippings
- Eggs & Dairy Products
- Small Branches & Untreated Wood
- Bones
- Yard Trimmings
- Fish
- Flowers
- Meat
- Food Soiled Napkins (in small quantities)
- Bread and Grains
- No Dirt or Rocks**
- Food Scraps
- No Palm Fronds**
- Fruits and Vegetables

RECYCLING



Make sure all items are dry and empty

- Paper
- Tin Cans
- Cardboard (flattened)
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Aluminum Cans
- #4-#7 Plastic Containers
- #2 & #3 Plastic Containers
- #1 PET Plastic
- Scrap Metal
- No Plastic Bags**, Place recyclables directly in your cart

LANDFILLS



All other items belong in the trash

- Juice Boxes & Milk Cartons
- To-Go Cups
- Bags & Wrappers
- Diapers, Used Paper Towels
- Plastic Utensils, Straws, Dirty Take-Out Containers
- Styrofoam, Plastic Film, Plastic Bags
- Bagged Pet Waste & Litter
- No Electronics**
